**Objectives:**

- building cooperation and exploring synergies between sustainable consumption and production (SCP) <sup>1</sup> capacity building activities and policies and development cooperation programmes;
- exploring ways to facilitate and mainstream the implementation of SCP/resource efficiency activities in development cooperation activities and support for policy making at country level;
- highlighting SCP contributions to achieve the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), including through green jobs initiatives, which contribute to poverty alleviation and the construction of a resource efficient, low carbon economy;
- exploring the linkages between SCP and green economy/green growth as well as between SCP and climate change in a development context.

**Expected Outcomes:**

Short-term

- strengthened cooperation between OECD's Development Assistance Committee Network on Environment and Development Cooperation (DAC-ENVIRONET) and UNEP – including UNEP's participation in DAC-ENVIRONET meetings and the participation of OECD and development agencies in the Commission for Sustainable Development (CSD) intersessional meeting on SCP to be organized in October/November 2010;
- start a joint study to develop the economic and social case for SCP in developing countries and its contributions to a green economy.

Longer term

- increase cooperation with the development agencies to formulate the programmes of the 10 Year Framework of Programmes (10YFP) to be discussed at the SCP intersessional meeting in autumn 2010 and reviewed at the CSD 2011.
- increased participation of development agencies in regional SCP strategies and Task Forces of the Marrakech Process (on issues such as sustainable public procurement, sustainable buildings and construction, sustainable tourism and sustainable lifestyles).
